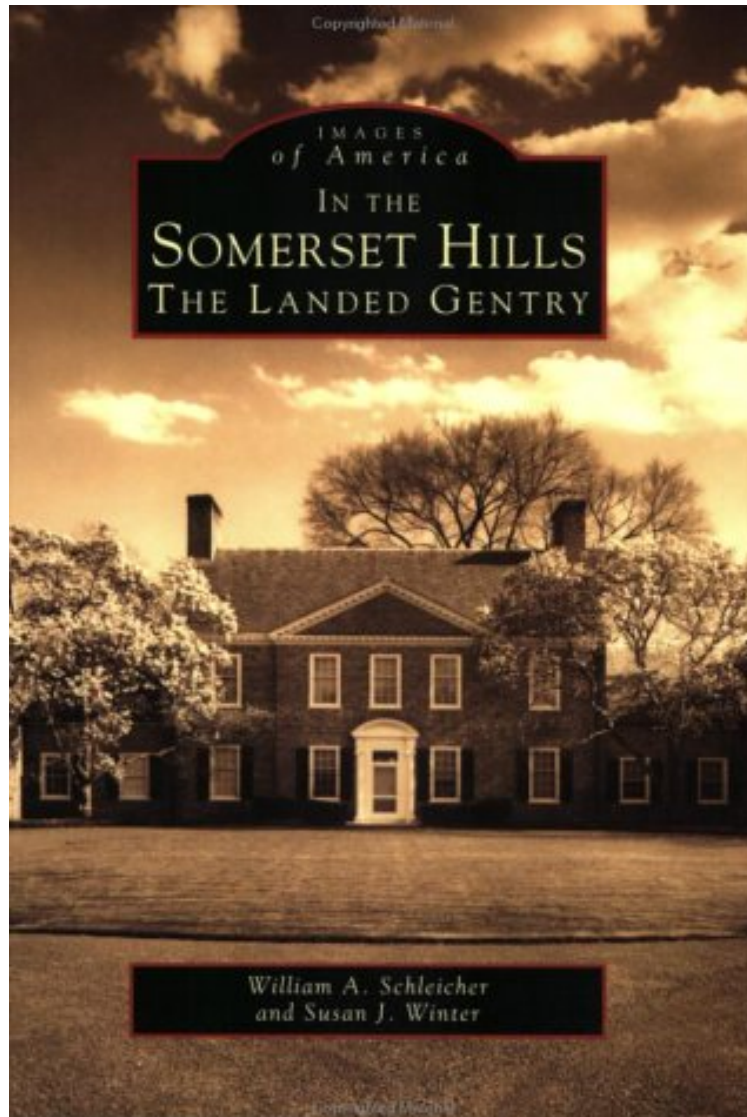

of rolling estates of old money and the captains of industry. Even today, Somerset Co. is listed as the #1 wealthiest county (of 20,000 nationwide) in terms of per capita income. The estates this has produced as some of the loveliest and beautiful in North America. Some of these Arcadia local history books are better than others, and William Schleicher and Sue Winter's are all among the very best. Gifted historians and writers (see their journal articles on Samuel Sutphin for example), they have each spent 30 years absorbed in Somerset County history. As long-time heads of the local historical society, and Rev. War collectors and reenactors, they were uniquely qualified for this task. And it shows. A must have for anyone living near Somerset County, or anyone with genealogical interests in the region. Especially fun to introduce your children to the local history.
