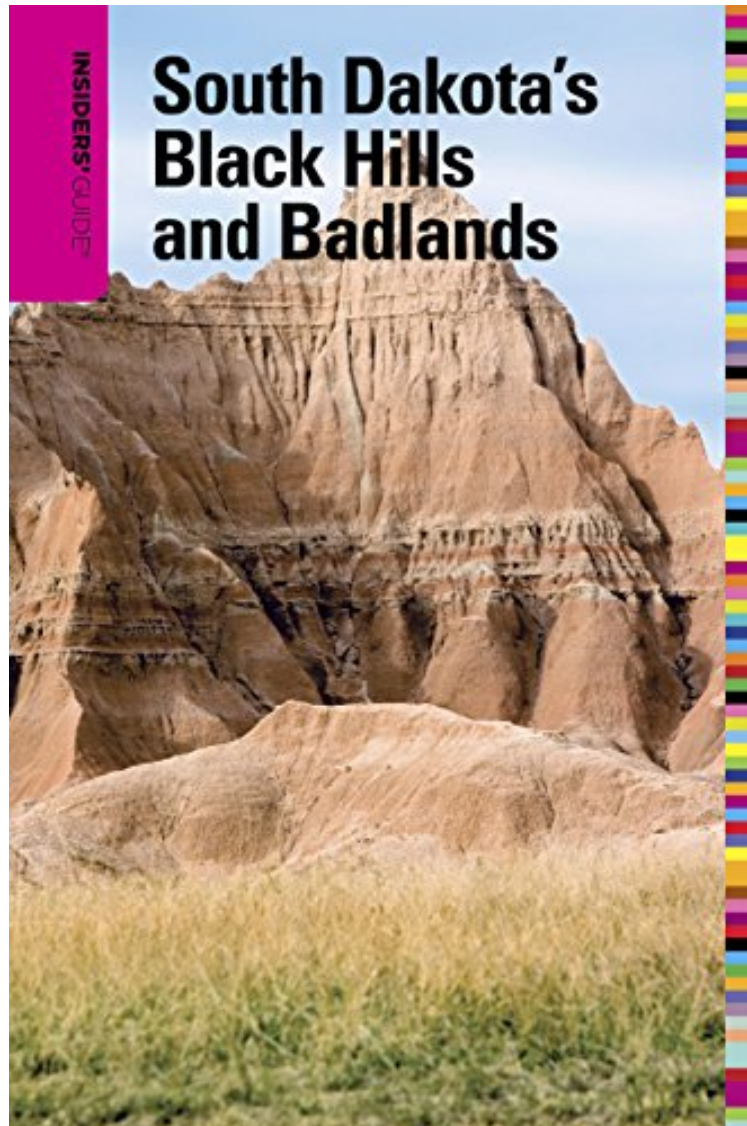

absolutely useless because of the content organization. Rather than having chapters focus on a particular area or city in the Black Hills, each chapter topic, ie Accommodations, Attractions, Shopping etc, includes information for the entire region. Thus if one wishes to read about a specific city, for example, Deadwood, one must sort through every chapter in the book to get a complete picture of what is available. I purchased this book several years ago when we made our first trip to the Black Hills, but we did not use it. I should have tossed it out. This spring we are returning for another visit, so I pulled the book out, forgetting that it hadn't worked as a guide for us. After again trying to use the book for travel research I put it aside.
