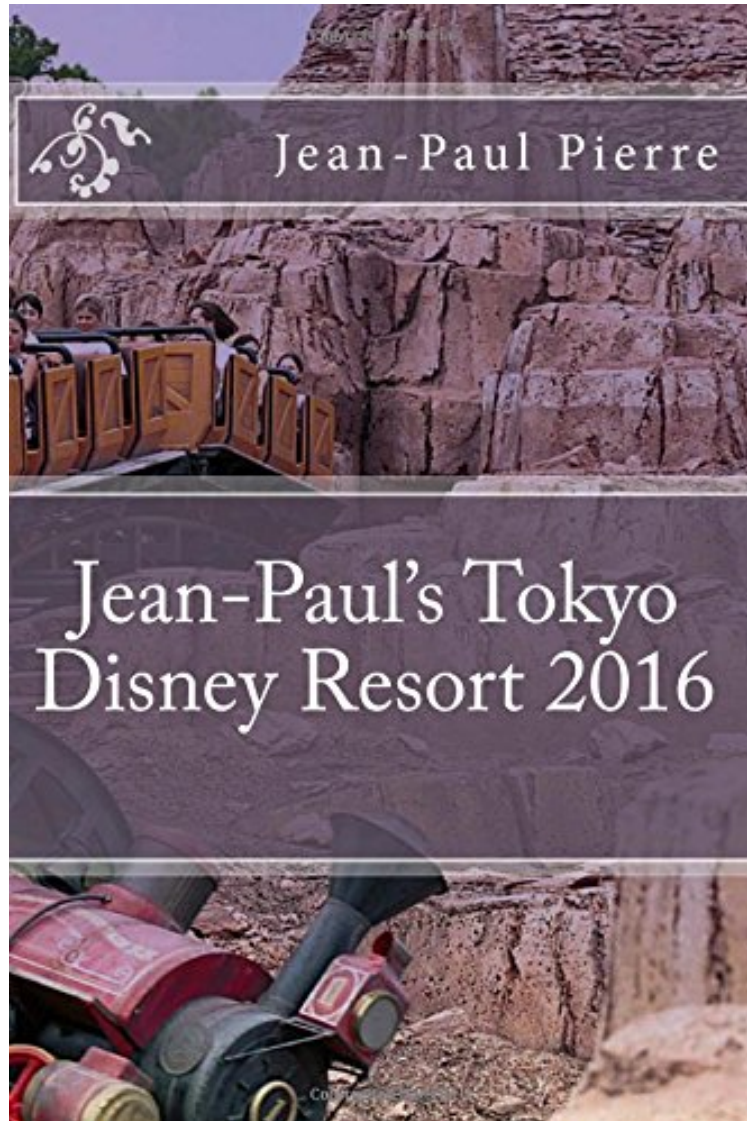

It's rife with typographical errors, which I assume persist in the Kindle version. It appears the print version is no longer available, perhaps due to the errors.Worse than the numerous typos are the many, many factual errors. I have not yet visited the Tokyo Disney Resort, but I spotted more problems than I could count. Some issues are obvious, like noting that Tokyo Disneyland's Country Bear Theater is a great place to escape the Florida

sun. Some errors are easy for a Disney Parks fan to spot, like the 4-paragraph-long description of the Star Tours queue, with its references to the Tomorrowland '98 theme and Adventures thru Inner Space. Any Disneyland fan would know the author is describing Anaheim's version. It's obvious that the author copied and pasted from other sources--presumably his other books about other Disney parks--to cobble together much of this book. Worst of all are the factual errors that could cause real disappointment to visitors, like suggesting the reader catch a quick lunch meal at the cafe and show at the Diamond Horseshoe. The Tokyo Disneyland website notes that both lunch and dinner shows at the Diamond Horseshoe require reservations, as they are scheduled shows. Even the "Look Inside" portion of the book on describes Cinderella's Fairy Tale Hall as a princess meet and greet, when I understand it is a walk-through. The book has little or no information about which rides/shows are in Japanese or English, which was the one thing I thought I could reasonably expect from an English-language guide to Tokyo Disney Resort. There is substantial information about disabled access for each ride, but given the other errors, I have no confidence in its validity. I am left kind of wondering if the author has even visited Tokyo Disney Resort at all. Interestingly, it appears that Elijah's Tokyo Disney Resort 2016 is identical to this book, and that there may be as many as 6 basically identical versions of the book, all with different authors listed. One can only speculate why a poorly written guidebook would be published under so many different pen names. (This particular book advises readers to go to guidebooks.co for updates. I couldn't find any updates for this book, but all the books listed on that site are Elijah's.) Readers who know anything about Tokyo Disney Resort will be frustrated by the errors in this book. Readers who know nothing about the resort could easily be misled by the many incorrect statements here. Even if you read it free on Kindle Unlimited, I suggest you double-check the content for accuracy before using it to plan your trip.
