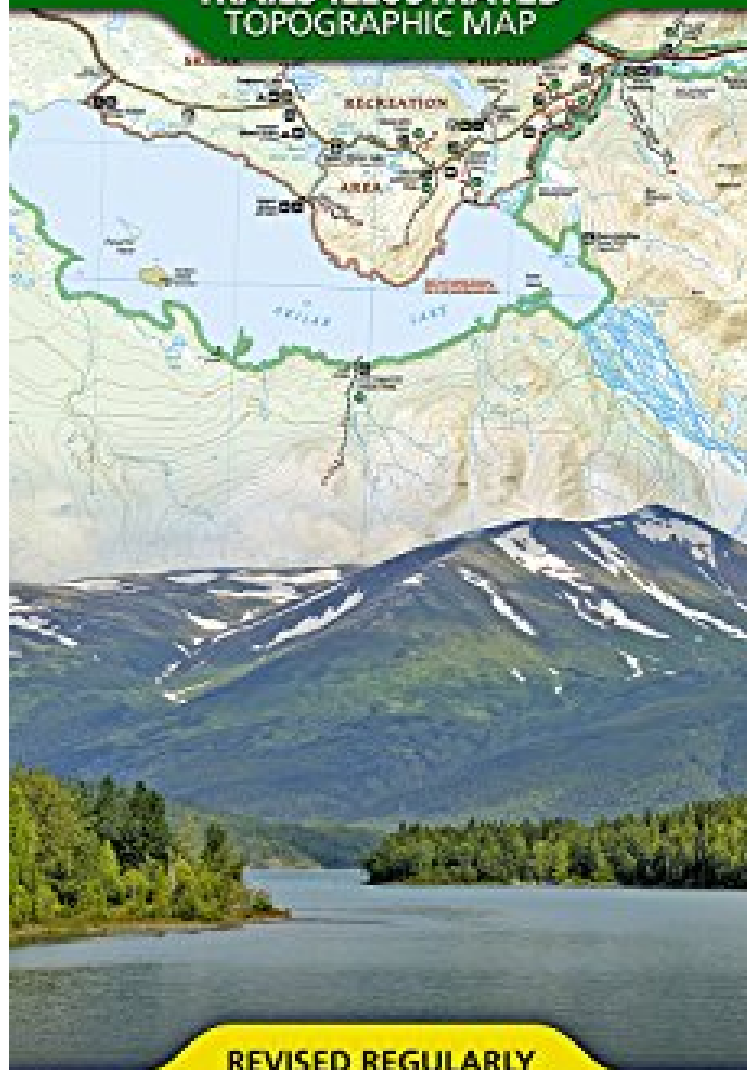

This topographic map is water resistant, flexible, easily to read and easily transported in a pocket or rucksack.The map has two sides. One side begins at Turnagain Arm off Cook Inlet and covers the Seward Highway as far south as Kenai Lake, the Hope Cutoff, the Johnson Pass Trail, the Resurrection Pass Trail, and the trails around Kenai and Crescent Lakes. The other side covers the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge, the Kenai River west of Cooper Landing and the Skilak Lake Area, and Tustumena Lake.The scale of the map is 1:105,000, which may seem a little big for those used to the 1:20,000 maps used back East on, say, the Appalachian Trail. However, the scale of the outdoors in Alaska almost demands it. Among the quiet highlights: the Gull Rock Trail west of the old mining town of Hope, the snowmachine routes in Turnagain Pass, and the canoe routes in the Wildlife Refuge."Kenai NWR and Chugach National Forest, Alaska" map is very highly recommended to those planning some outdoor recreation on the Kenai Peninsula.
