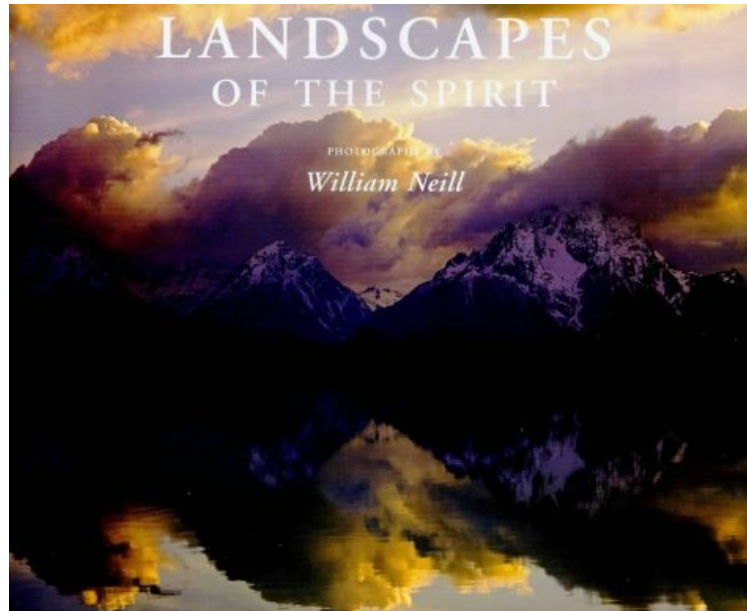

Neill has a talent for composing images that are works of art in and of themselves, but his true talent is finding that time of light, that presence of twilight, the mystery of fog, the joy of sunrises and sunsets that imbue his subject matter with what can only be defined as the spiritual essence.
