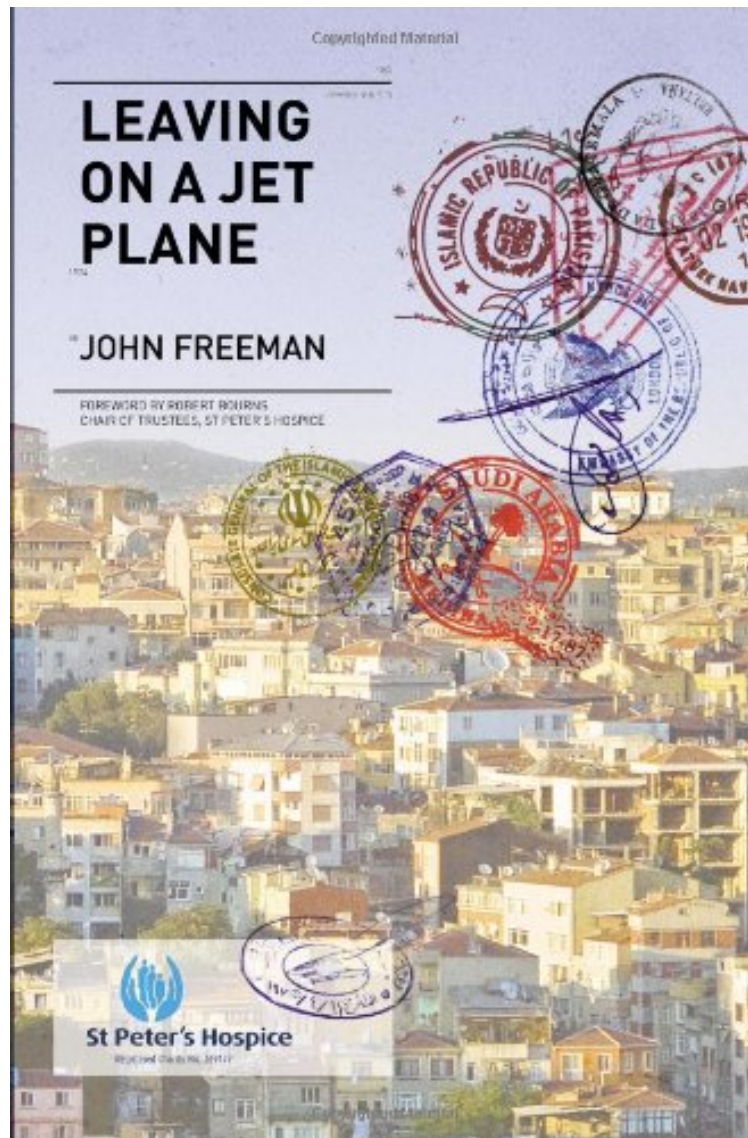

Eventually as the Middle East started to use oil wealth to develop its own industries, John started travelling regularly to the area in 1974 and continued to do so until his retirement.
