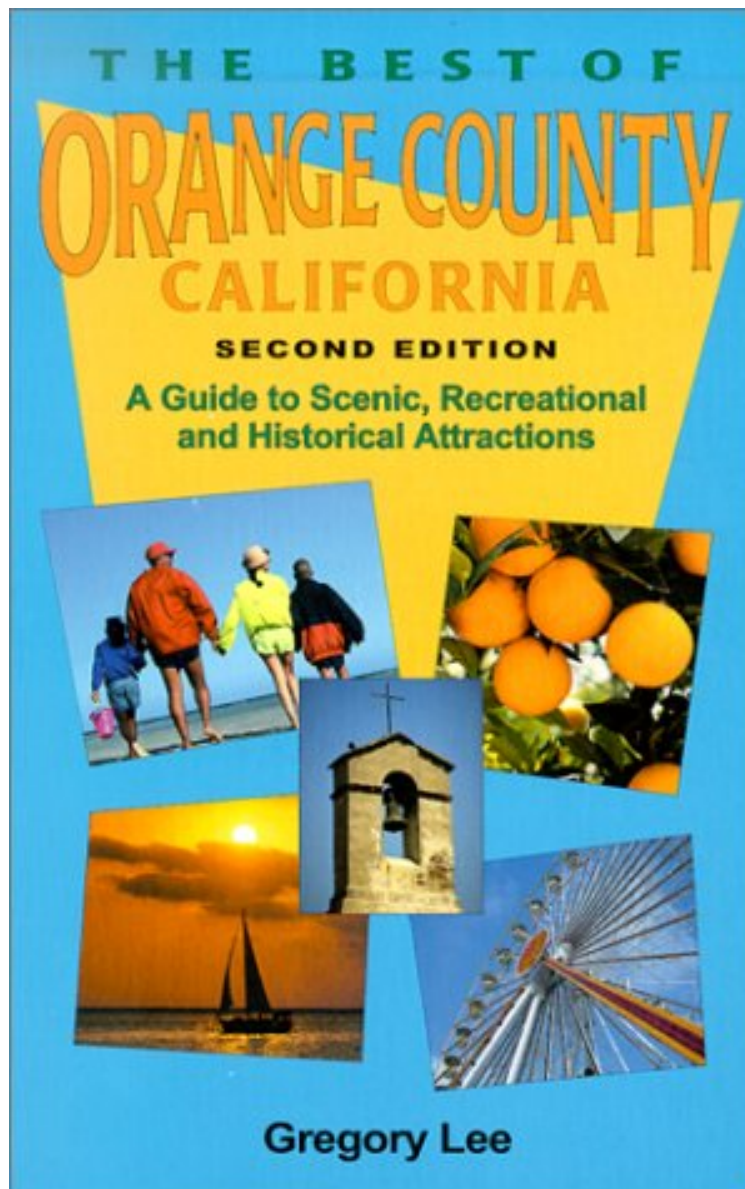

Lee brings a breath of fresh air amid all of the negative publicity about Southern California. The author, a native of Orange County, correctly points out that Orange County, often overshadowed by its larger neighbor, Los Angeles County, has plenty to offer tourists and residents alike. It boasts some of the best restaurants in Southern California, some of the swankiest hotels, and the wildest beaches this side of Venice. Disneyland is one of the top tourist attractions in the world, and this breezy, well-written book tells travelers what to do outside of the Magic Kingdom.
