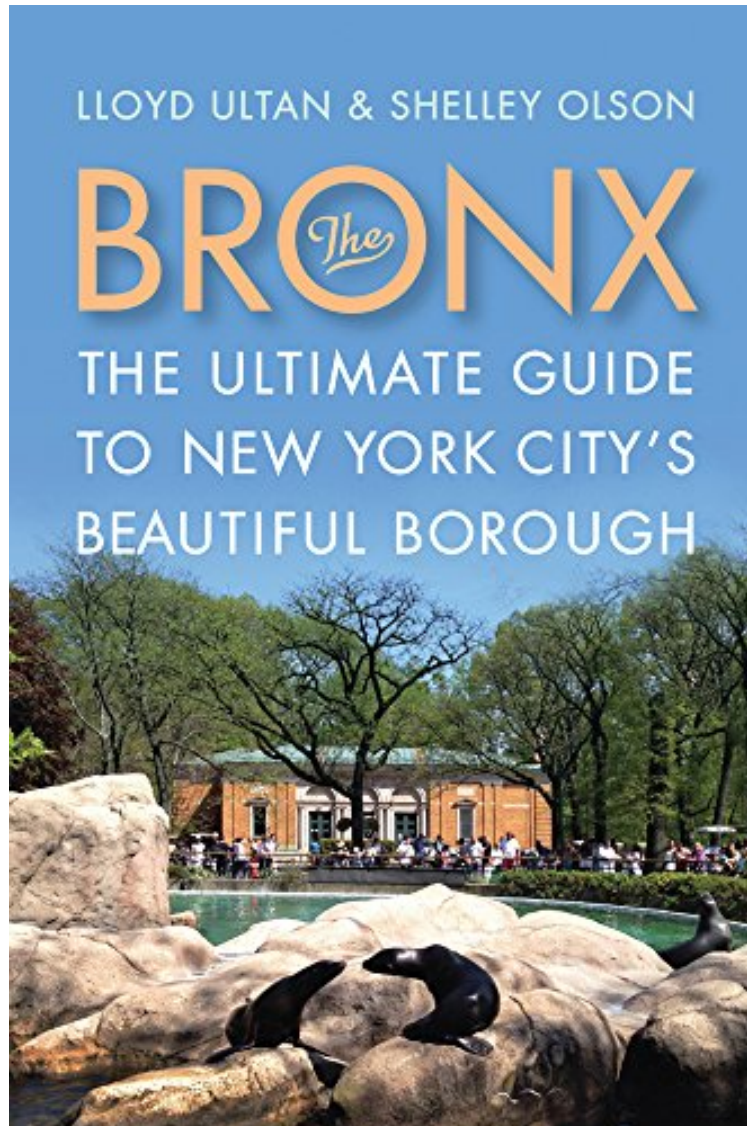

Few tourists venture into the badlands of the Bronx! This is a mistake, as the Bronx has beautiful scenery, interesting architecture, and a fascinating history. The much-reputed danger here is hardly a problem during the daytime, and many Bronx neighborhoods are always quite safe. This new book tells at length about the various bona fide "tourist attractions" in the borough, but is short on suggestions for walks. It cannot be compared to the books Walking Brooklyn and Walking Queens (both by by Adrienne Onofri); or the comprehensive books about the neighborhoods of the same boroughs (the former by Kenneth T. Jackson and John B. Manbeck; the latter by Claudia Gryvatz Copquin) - nothing similar exists about the Bronx (or Staten Island, for that matter). But yet, the book is definitely recommended.

The Bronx is more than a zoo and a stadium, but if you're coming to visit us--even if it's to come to a game--you will benefit from having Lloyd Ultan, probably the most knowledgeable Bronx guide in the business, show you around the only New York City borough attached to the mainland. In addition to detailed descriptions of various sites, there are several suggested walking tours. This book is well worth it just for the walking tour of the Grand Concourse, which you can take before that Yankee game which brought you here.

Often overlooked by most tourists and locals alike, the Bronx one of five boroughs that comprise the city of New York is rich in cultural and historical attractions. From the Bronx Zoo (the largest urban zoo in the United States) to the New York Botanical Garden (one of the most visited botanical gardens in the world), this borough has something for everyone.
