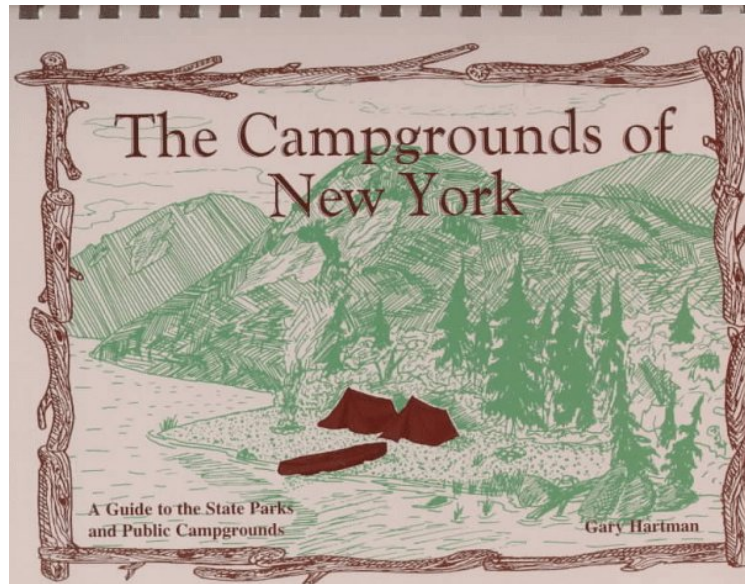

I purchased this book by (and for) the title THE CAMPGROUNDS OF NEW YORK. I really wanted in-depth information about campgrounds in NY State. Sadly this isn't the resource I wanted/needed. This is the book for you if you are looking for basic Dept of Environmental Conservation PR material all put together into one place. If that's what you desire and you aren't into doing even a little web surfing, buy this book. Personally, I wanted a book that tells what it's like to visit the park(s) in question. Is it dog friendly? Is it good for hardcore campers is it better suited for families? What is the feel of the campground? Is it good for boating? If "yes" is it good for kayaking or big motorboats? (an example is Rollins Pond and Fish Creek are next door to each other but miles apart in terms of types of boating. Which is good for me? This book doesn't answer that question or any other ones). Do they have a staff that does activities with kids/families? Again, you don't get that with this book. All you get is DEC PR stuff coughed back at you. As I said, if that's what you want, go for it.
