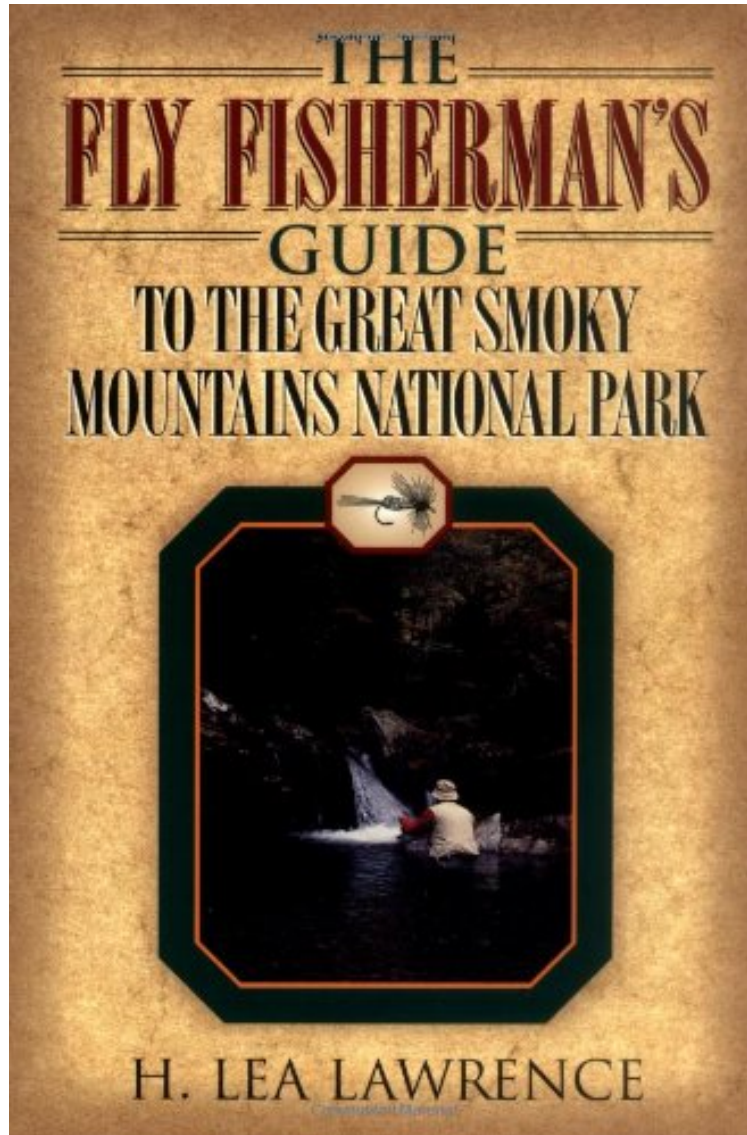

After so many pages, it jumped forward again to somewhere in the 100s. There was no table of contents, to make matters worse.
